Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to approve the minutes from the 3-13-23 meeting

Mr. Dixon: Second

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

CLAIMS TO BE PAID

Mr. McKinley: Claims to be paid for March 27th, 2023. I am showing \$122,916.39 of which \$65,274.97 is the Police department.

Mr. Dixon: I make a motion to accept the claims of the Police department as stated

Mr. Clendenen: Second

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Mr. McKinley: The Fire Department I am showing \$57,641.42.

Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to accept the claims of the Fire department as stated

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

MUNICIPAL DEVELOPOMENT

Trinna Davis Simmons: Good evening. I have quite a bit for you today. Please do the bids first. 2314 Dewey first.

Tim Lanane: Jashroyer Group, LLC in the amount of \$8655. Madco Excavating in the amount of \$5600. Resue Demolition in the amount of \$10,250. And last Salty Dog Trash and recycling in the amount of \$6990.

Mr. Dixon: I make a motion to approve the bid from Madco Excavating in the amount \$5600.

Mr. Clendenen: Second

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Tim Lanane: The next bids are for 428 West 4th St. The first bid is from Jashroyer Group, LLC in the amount of \$9225. Rescue Demolition in the amount of \$10,250. And Salty Dog Trash and Recycling in the amount of \$20,000.

Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to approve Rescue Demolition in the amount of \$9225.

Mr. Dixon: Second

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Mr. McKinley: Do you have any more?

Trinna Davis Simmons; Yes, I do. I have properties that I need affirmed for demo. I think that last week there was a typo. Last meeting, we affirmed 1631 Fletcher when it should have been 1621 Fletcher. The husband is deceased and the wife came in and signed an agreement to have the property demolished. So, I need this affirmed.

Tim Lanane: What is her name and the relationship to the owner.

Trinna Davis Simmons: Her name is Anna Perry. She is the owner. Since she signed the agreement, we take it down for free.

Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to affirm 1621 Fletcher for demolition.

Mr. Dixon: Second.

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Trinna Davis Simmons: The next property is 2103 Central Ave. The owner of this property is deceased. It has been advertised in the newspaper. I have sent a certified letter. It ran in the paper on 3/11/23 and 3/18/23. I have heard nothing from any heirs or anything. We are asking this to be affirmed for emergency demo.

Tim Lanane: Was this a burn out?

Trinna Davis Simmons: Yes, the squatter's broke in and caught it on fire. There is an immediate need.

Mr. Dixon: I make a motion to approve the emergency demo of 2103 Central Ave.

Mr. Clendenen: Second.

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Trinna Davis Simmons: The next one is 2225 Fletcher. They have accepted the paperwork. They have a dumpster out there and working on it. I would like to re-schedule this for a four-month review. My next one is 1907 Fletcher St. It is another burn out for emergency demo. Squatters caught this on fire. It is a complete burnout. Patty got a call today saying someone wanted to buy it. There was a for sale sign on it for like \$12,000 or \$14,000. It was posted in the paper and I sent a certified letter on 3/11/23 and 3/18/23. They accepted the letter. The owner has not called in.

Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to approve the emergency demo of 1907 Fletcher St.

Mr. Dixon: Second.

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

Trinna Davis Simmone: The last one I have is 2127 West 16th. It is a burn out also. It also has been in the paper 3/11/23 and 3/18/23. This gentleman was in his 90's. I know of no other heirs

Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to approve the emergency demo for 2127 West 16th St.

Mr. Dixon: Second

Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 3-0 no. Motion passed.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

6. Rifle (Serial # J25884) Muzzleloader

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Mayor Broderick spoke to the citizens and the new hires regarding our wonderful Fire department, our paramedics and Police department

Chief Cravens: He have seven new recruits that we asking your approval for. Tiffany Hudson, 34 years old, Anderson resident. She is a nationally registered EMT and is currently attending Paramedic school. Carson Douglas is 21 years old from Markleville. He is currently employed with East Madison Fire Territory as an EMS driver. Corbin Maddox is 24 years old from Yorktown. He is currently employed as a rehabilitation aide at Athletico rehabilitation therapy in Anderson. Cameron Collins is 21 years old. He is a part time firefighter/EMT with East Madison Fire Territory. Michaela Mehling is a 25-year-old who is a Pendleton resident and firefighter/EMT at Adams township Fire Protection Territory. William Johnson is 30 years old Anderson resident. He comes to Anderson Fire department with several State Certification including EMT, Firefighter 1&2, Hazmat awareness and Ops, and Fire officer strategy and tactics. Last is Courtney Stowers a 29-year-old She has several state certificates including EMT, firefighter 1&2, Haz Mat Awareness.

Rebecca Crumes: Sir, do you have a card?


Marvin Austin: I do. Thank you.
